2/ Languages of Morocco (48h)

- Moroccan Arabic (Darija)
- Introduction to the Amazigh language

3/ Cultural and scientific immersion activities

Optional - 2 hour workshops

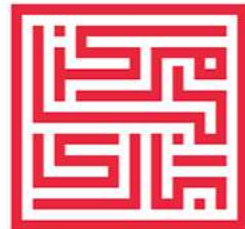
- Visits to Moroccan libraries
